We will also conduct MOCK interviews for both Supervisor and Postmaster positions so you know what kind of questions to expect.

EVERY PARTICIPANT will receive a CD to take with them loaded with material, information and tools you need to prepare from home for your next interview, job posting and to increase your postal knowledge.

There will be Postmasters on site conducting interviews and answering ANY QUESTIONS you may have on the process and what it takes to get promoted.
