A special thanks to our Convention Chairs, Tracy Canby and Andrea Leyes, for all of their hard work who together, planned an outstanding convention.


This is a huge task that is supported by those on the following page of volunteers.

Keeping that in mind, please note the following so that EVERYONE can participate and come away with memories and friendship that will last a lifetime:


- Please wear your I.D badge at all times


